

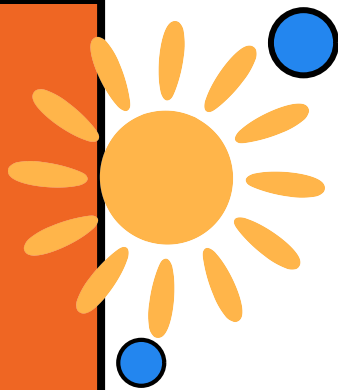

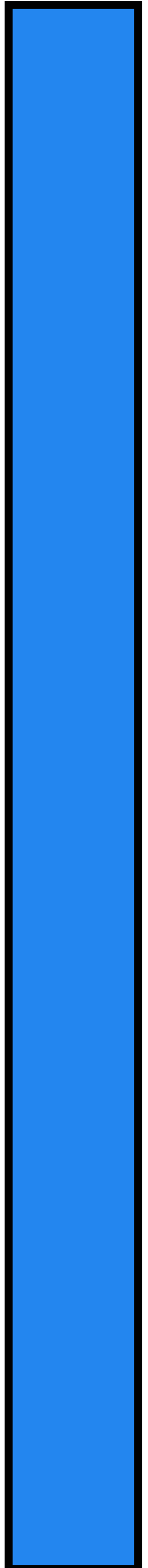

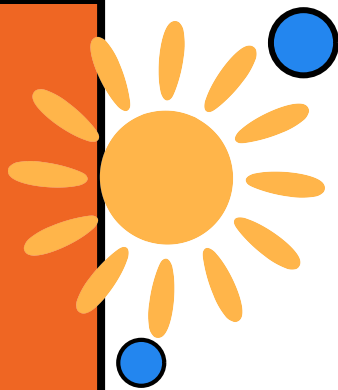
We hope that your child loves using this journal.

DAY 1

Hebrews 10:25 NIV

This scripture reminds us how important it is to be together with other people who believe in God. Imagine if you're going to school and you really like being with your friends because it makes you happy and helps you learn better. In the same way, this verse tells us it's good to gather with friends at church or in groups where we can talk about God, share, and support each other.

It's like when you play a team sport--being together helps everyone cheer each other on and have more fun! Sometimes, people might feel shy or think they can do it all alone, but this verse encourages us not to forget to come together. It says we should encourage one another, which means we help each other feel good and stay strong in our faith.

Prayer: Pray for people who are not apart of a church family.

ACTIVITY:

Draw a picture, write or tell to your parent what you like most about attending Freedom Kidz on Sunday morning.

DAY 2

Psalms 100:4 NIV



This scripture reminds us to be thankful and praise God when we think about God and when we come into his presence. It says that when we come close to God, we should do it with a happy heart!

Imagine you're going to a big party at a friend's house. When you arrive, you might say thank you for inviting you, and you'd want to celebrate and have fun, right? This verse tells us to be thankful and happy when we think about God, too. So, when we pray or sing to God, we can say thank you for all the good things in our lives, like our family, friends, and even our toys.

Being thankful makes our hearts happy, and God loves when we praise him! So, let's remember to say thank you and celebrate how great God is!"

Prayer: Pray for people who don't know God.



DAY 3

1 Thessalonians 5:11 NIV

This scripture reminds us that we should always be kind to each other and help each other feel better and do better. That includes what we say out of our mouths and do with our bodies (hands, feet etc.).

Just like how we can build a tall tower with blocks, we can help build each other up by being nice and supportive.

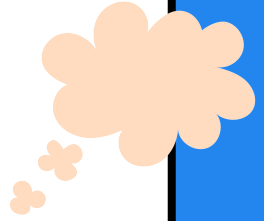
Prayer: Pray for the kids at your school that had a bad day today.

DAY 4

1 Corinthians 12:27 NIV



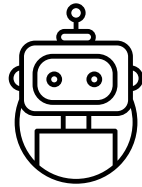
Imagine if everyone in your class was a part of one big robot! Each of you would be a different part, like a leg, an arm, or even the head. If one part is missing, the robot wouldn't work right.

In this verse, Paul is telling us that everyone in the church is special and plays an important role, just like the parts of a robot. Some people might be good at teaching, others at helping or showing kindness, and that's all important.

So, when we all work together and support each other, we help make the whole group work well, just like a perfectly functioning robot! Each person is valuable and has their own special job to do!

Pray that everyone in the church will know what they do well and do their part.

ACTIVITY:



Draw your best Freedom Kidz robot or discuss with your parent what you are good at and how you can use that talent/skill at Freedom Kidz.

DAY 5

1 Thessalonians 5:17 NIV

This means that we can talk to God at all times, whenever we want, throughout our day, no matter what we're doing.

This helps us feel close to God and lets Him know what's on our hearts. Remember, God loves to hear from us!

Prayer: Pray for help to remember that you can talk to God anytime, anywhere, about anything.

DAY 6



Psalm 119:105 NIV

Imagine you're in a dark room, and you have a flashlight. If you turn it on, it helps you see where you are going so you don't bump into things. God's Word, which is the Bible, is like that flashlight for our lives.

When we read the Bible and learn about God, it helps us know how to make good choices and be kind to others. Just like a lamp helps you see in the dark,

God's words help us see the right way to live. So when we trust and follow God, we can walk confidently and safely on our life's journey!

Prayer: Thank God for His Word and ask Him for help to follow His guidance each day.

ACTIVITY:

DAY 7

Psalm 95:6 NIV

This verse tells us something very special about how we can show love and respect to God. Imagine if you really loved someone, like your parents or a close friend. When you want to show how much you care about them, you might give them a big hug or say nice things, right?

Well, this verse is asking us to do something like that for God! It tells us that we should come together and show that we respect Him. When it says 'bow down' or 'kneel,' it means that we can lower our bodies as a way to say, 'God, we think You are amazing and we want to honor You!'

So, it's like giving God a big hug with our hearts and showing Him we really appreciate everything He does for us.

Prayer: Ask God to help you remember to worship Him every day by singing, praying, kneeling before Him, and showing love to others.

DAY 8

James 1:22 NIV

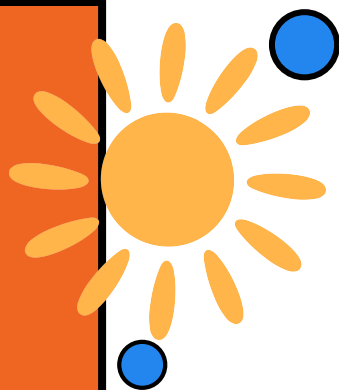


This verse says that we should not just listen to God's words, but we need to do what they say!

Imagine if your parent tells you to clean up your toys. If you just listen but don't actually pick up your toys, then you didn't really follow the instructions.

So, this verse is like a reminder that it's important to not only hear good things but to act on them, too. If we learn something kind or helpful, like sharing with friends or being nice to others, we should try our best to do those things. This way, we are not just good listeners but also good helpers!

Prayer: Thank God for giving you His Word to guide you. Ask God to help you not just to listen but to do what it says.



DAY 9

Acts 2:46 NIV

This verse of the Bible talks about what some of Jesus' friends did after he went to heaven.

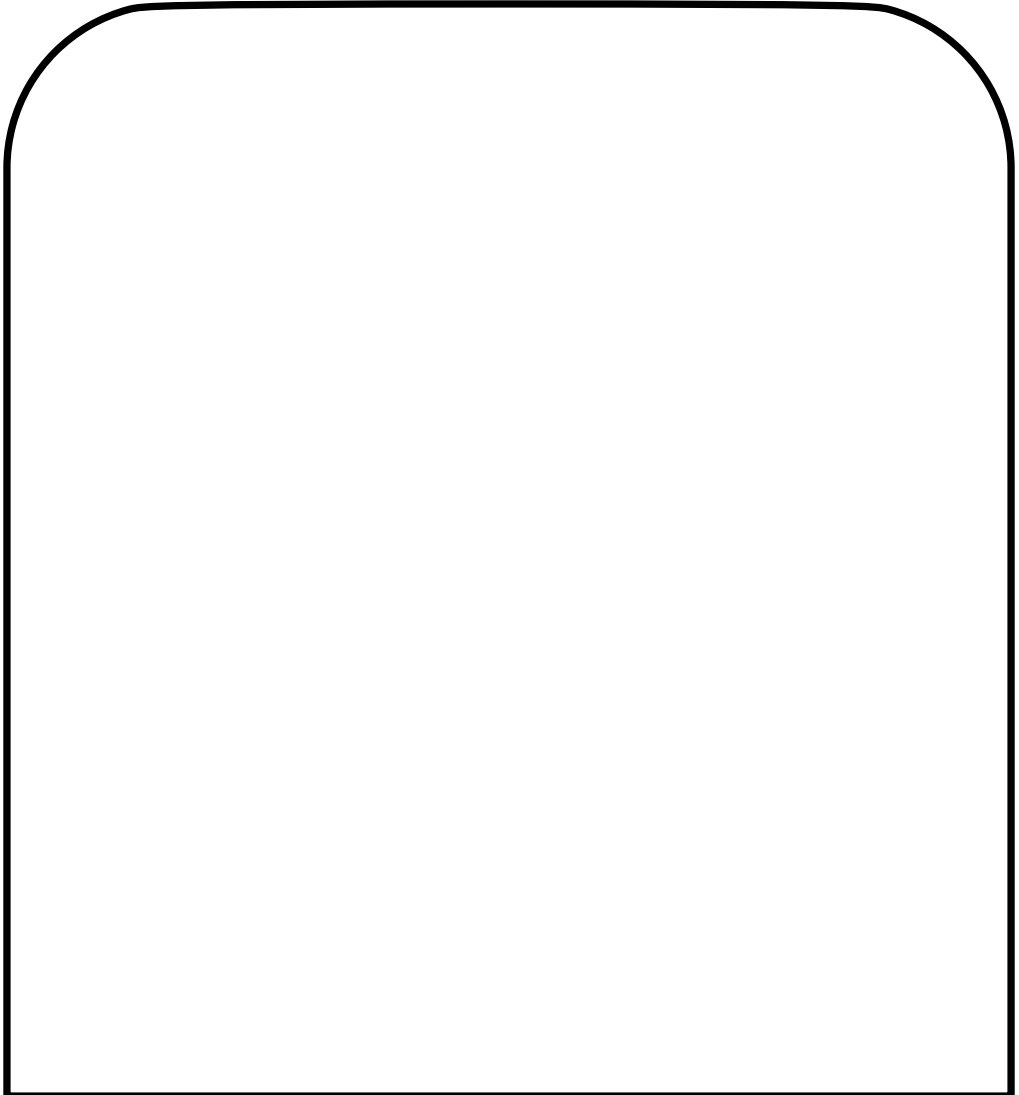
Imagine you and your friends decide to have some fun and eat together every day. In Acts 2:46, it says the friends of Jesus did something similar! They would gather together each day to share their meals, have fun, and talk about how much they loved Jesus and what he had taught them.

They were happy, and they enjoyed spending time together, just like when we have family dinners or snack time with friends! It reminds us that having friends and sharing meals can bring us joy and help us feel close to each other and to God.

Prayer: Thank God for giving you people to share your life with. Ask God for help to always be kind and joyful when we spend time with your family and friends.

ACTIVITY:

Draw a big table with food and people sitting around it smiling. Make sure to include your family, friends, or even people you'd like to share with. You can also discuss how sharing with others shows God's love and brings joy.



DAY 10

Galatians 6:2 NIV



Imagine you have a big backpack filled with heavy books. It's really hard to carry all by yourself, right? Now think about how nice it would be if a friend helped you carry it!

In this verse, God is teaching us that it's important to help each other when things get tough. Just like we can share the weight of a heavy backpack, we can also share our worries and problems with our friends and family. When we help each other, we show love and kindness, which is what Jesus wants us to do!

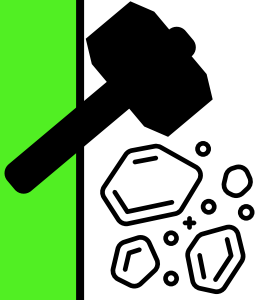
So, if someone is feeling sad or has a problem, we can be there for them and help them out, just like a good friend would.

Prayer: Thank God for teaching us to help and love one another. Ask God to help you see when others need your help.

DAY 11

Proverbs 27:17 NIV

Imagine you have a big, sharp rock and a smaller rock. If you rub them together, the big rock can make the little rock sharper and smoother.

This means that friends can help each other become better, just like that! When we spend time with our friends and help each other with things, like learning, being kind, and trying hard, we can make each other better people. So, it's important to have good friends who help us grow!

That way, they can understand how helping and learning from one another is important!

Prayer: Thank God for giving us friends and family to help us grow and become better. Ask God to help you be kind, encouraging, and loving toward others.

DAY 12

Ephesians 2:19 NIV



This verse reminds us that we are no longer strangers or outsiders when we believe in Jesus.

Instead, we become part of God's family. Imagine you have a big family. Sometimes, people might feel left out and not know where they belong.

But when we believe in Jesus, it's like being adopted into a loving family where everyone is welcome! In God's family, we have each other and get to help one another.

Prayer: Thank God for welcoming you into His family and for loving you so much. Ask God to help you love and include others as He does.

ACTIVITY:

DAY 13

2 Corinthians 9:7 NIV

The Bible says that God loves a cheerful giver. This means that when we share what we have or help others, we should do it happily and not because we feel forced to.

Imagine if you have some yummy cupcakes and you want to share them with your friends. If you give them the cupcakes with a big smile and say, "I'm so happy to share these with you!" that is being a cheerful giver.

But if you were to give the cupcakes while crossing your arms and saying, "Ugh, I guess you can have some," that wouldn't be very nice.

So, the verse teaches us that it's good to share and help others, but it's even better when we do it with a joyful heart. God loves it when we are happy to give and share, just like He gives to us!

Prayer: Thank God for giving you so much and ask Him to help you share with others happily and willingly.

Color the picture below, or discuss with your parents what it means to be a cheerful giver and how can you give cheerfully at home, school, or church.

DAY 14



1 Peter 4:10 NIV

This verse talks about how each person has special gifts and abilities that God gives them. Think of it like this: just like superheroes have special powers, everyone has their own special things they can do really well.

The verse tells us that we should use those gifts to help others. Imagine you have a toy that makes a fun sound, and you share it with your friends to make them smile.

That's like using your special gift! When we help each other, we're showing love, just like how God shows love to us.

Prayer: Thank God for the unique gifts He gives and ask Him to help us use them to serve others.

ACTIVITY:

In the space below trace your hand, write or draw one reason per finger, a way that you can serve others (e.g., helping parents, sharing toys, praying for friends).



DAY 15

Proverbs 3:9 NIV

This verse is like a special reminder for us. It tells us to make sure we don't forget about God when we have nice things or when we do well at something, like getting a good grade or earning some money.

Imagine if you had a jar of cookies, and you wanted to share some with your best friend. You would want to give them the yummiest cookie, right? This verse is saying that we honor God when we give Him the best of what we have, like our time, our love, or even some of the things we have earned.

So, honoring God means being grateful for what we have and sharing it with Him in special ways, just like sharing those yummy cookies!

Prayer: Thank God for His blessings and ask for help in giving Him our best.

ACTIVITY:

Create a "Firstfruits Giving Jar." Take a plastic cup and decorate the outside of the cup however you like. Every week, place a portion of your allowance or spare change in the jar to give at church or help someone in need.



DAY 16

Acts 20:36 NIV



In this scripture we see Paul, a very important leader and teacher in the early Christian church, saying goodbye to his friends.

Paul had taught and traveled with these people for a long time, and he loved them very much. When Paul finished talking to them, he prayed with them. Praying is talking to God, asking for help and saying thank you.

Then, they all hugged and cried because they knew they might not see each other again for a long time. This story shows us how important it is to care for our friends and to talk to God when we are feeling sad or grateful.

Prayer: Thank God for the lesson, and ask God to help you pray for others.

ACTIVITY:

Just as Paul prayed with others, make a circle with the other people in your household and take turns saying a prayer out loud.



DAY 17

Matthew 28:19 NIV

In this verse Jesus tells His friends (the disciples) to go everywhere and tell people about Him. He wanted them to teach everyone how to love God and each other.

When Jesus said, 'Go and make disciples of all nations,' He meant that everyone, no matter where they live, should know about Him.

He also talked about 'baptizing them in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.' That means, when people decide to follow Jesus, they can get baptized, which is an outward expression of an inner decision that you have made to follow Jesus.

So, basically, this verse is about sharing Jesus' love with everyone and helping them believe in Him, too. It's like being a superhero for Jesus, spreading good news and making friends all over the world!"

Prayer: Pray for God to help you be bold in sharing your faith with others and to show them how they can be disciples.

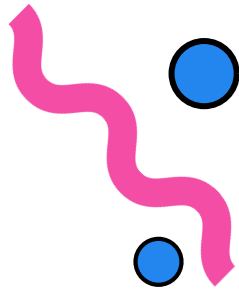
ACTIVITY:

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DAY 18

Isaiah 6:8 NIV

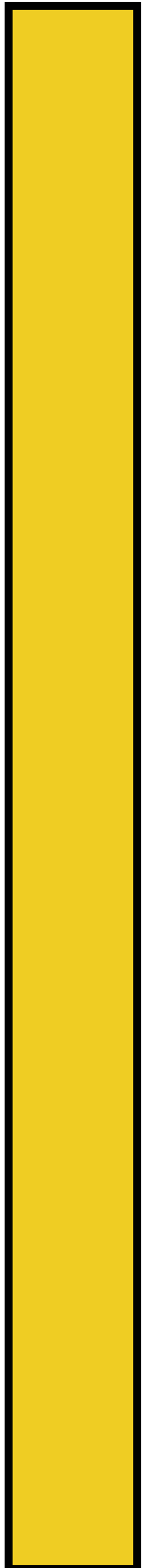


God has a special mission for everyone, no matter how old or young.

In Isaiah 6:8, Isaiah hears God asking, "Who will go for me?" Isaiah's response was simple but brave: "Here I am, send me!" God loves when we are willing to say "Yes" to Him.

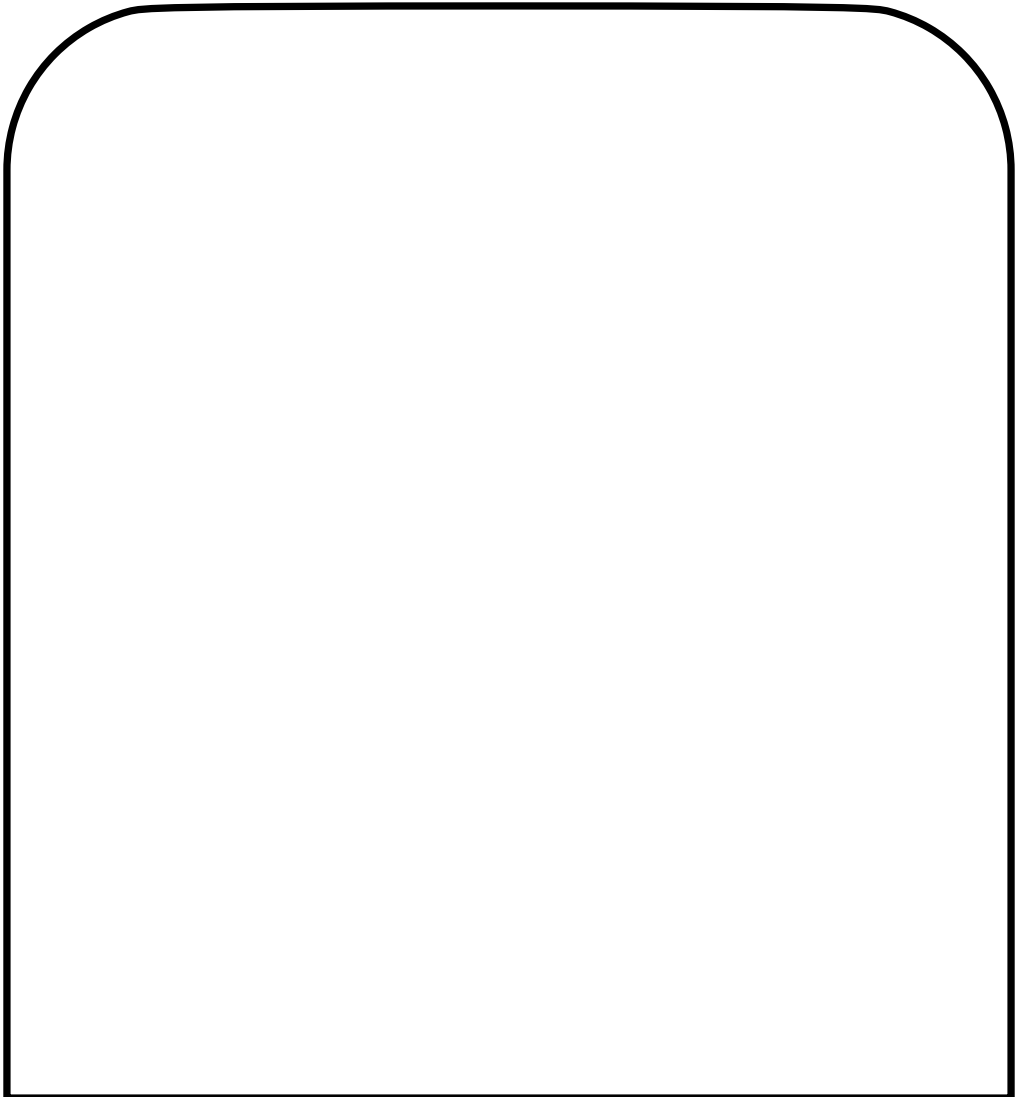
Saying "Yes" might mean helping someone, being kind, or telling a friend about Jesus. Even kids can say, "Here I am, send me!" and be part of God's big plan.

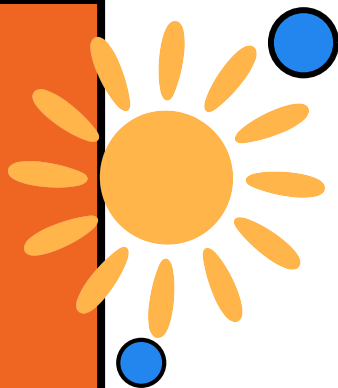
Prayer: Thank God for calling you to be part of His big plans. Ask for help to be brave like Isaiah and say, 'Here I am, send me!'

DAY 19

Romans 10:15 NIV

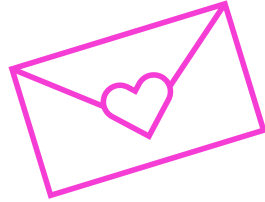
Did you know God says feet can be beautiful? Not because of how they look but because of what they do!

In Romans 10:15, the Bible tells us that people who bring the good news about Jesus have beautiful feet. What is the good news? It's that Jesus loves everyone, forgives us, and wants us to be part of His family.

When we share this news with others through our words and actions, we become messengers for God. No matter how small you are, your "feet" can take you to places where you can share God's love.

Prayer: Thank God for giving you the good news about Jesus. Ask God for help to have 'beautiful feet' by sharing His love with others through our words and actions.

DAY 20



John 4:29-30 NIV

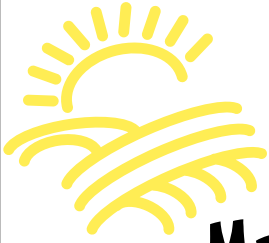
Jesus met a woman at a well. After talking with Him, she realized He was the Savior--the one sent by God to save us! She was so excited that she ran back to her town and told everyone, "Come and see!" Because of her invitation, many people came to see Jesus and believed in Him.

Sometimes, we might feel too small or unsure to invite others to Jesus. But just like the woman at the well, your invitation can make a big difference! You can invite friends to church, tell them about Jesus, or even show His love by being kind. God can use your words and actions to lead others to Him.

Prayer: Thank Jesus for showing you how much He loves you. Ask for help to be brave like the woman at the well and invite others to 'Come and see' all the amazing things about Jesus.

ACTIVITY:

Design a "Come and See" invitation. This could say something like, "Come to church with me!" or "Jesus loves you--let's talk!" Give the card to a friend or family this week. Discuss with your parents, who you can invite to church or tell about Jesus?



DAY 21

Matthew 9:37-38 NIV

There was a farmer who looked at his huge field full of ripe crops. He said, 'If I don't pick this soon, it will go bad.' But there were so many crops and not enough workers. He needed lots of helpers to gather the harvest before it was too late!"

God's world is like the field. The people are like the crops, and they need to know about Jesus. We are the workers who can help, and we should ask God to send more helpers.

Prayer: Thank God for the opportunity to be His workers. Ask God to help you share His love with others and to send more people to do His work.

ACTIVITY:

Activity: Memorize this scripture with the matching hand motions, "The harvest is plentiful" (spread arms wide). "But the workers are few" (hold up a small number of fingers). "Ask the Lord of the harvest" (fold hands in prayer). "To send out workers into his harvest field" (pretend to push people forward).
